Write a text in which a celebration doesn't go entirely to plan.


You may respond in any of the four forms. You should aim to write approximately 750 words of prose or 30 lines of poetry.

Assignment 3




Write a text in which someone uses language to conceal the truth rather than to communicate freely.

SECTION B

Write a critical commentary on the creative writing you have produced for Section A.

Your commentary should:

- comment on how you've used language, form and structure to develop ideas
- demonstrate awareness of your writing process and editorial decisions
- demonstrate awareness of the relationship between your own creative writing for Section A and the text you studied from the list of STIMULUS TEXTS.

You should aim to write at least 750 words.
